**INDUCTEES ANNOUNCED IN FEBRUARY**

Induction into the Show Jumping Hall of Fame is an honor bestowed annually upon select individuals whose accomplishments and contributions to the sport have set them apart and whose influence has had a significant impact on the sport of show jumping and the equestrian community. This year's inductees will be announced during the first week of February.

Being presented with the Show Jumping Hall of Fame International Award will be Kevin Babington, whose most notable successes include riding on Ireland's Gold medal team at the European Championships in 2001, finishing eighth individually at the World Equestrian Games in 2002, and placing fourth individually at the 2004 Athens Olympics, as well as winning many major Grand Prix such as the Hampton Classic, Silver Oak Jumper Tournament, and Lake Placid. He joins previous International Award winners Ian Millar (CAN), Rodrigo Pessoa (BRA) and Mario Deslauriers (CAN).

The Show Jumping Hall of Fame was organized to promote the sport of show jumping and to immortalize the legends of the men, women and horses who have made great contributions to the sport. The Show Jumping Hall of Fame is located at the Kentucky Horse Park in Lexington, Kentucky. Plaques honoring those who have been inducted into the Hall of Fame can be seen at the Horse Park's Rolex Stadium. Mementos and artifacts from the sport's history are on display as part of the Show Jumping Hall of Fame collection at the United States Hunter Jumper Association (USHJA) Wheeler Museum at the Horse Park.
